All children who take part in this Challenge will receive a charity wristband and a certificate.

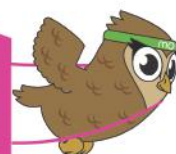

Grow £5 For Mo: Top Tips for Budding Entrepreneurs

CHALLENGE IDEA Hair Decorations

Use old school uniform or old clothes to make hair bands and clips. To buy: thread, cotton, elastic, plain clips

CHALLENGE IDEA Cake Sale

Everyone loves cakes, and you can organise a sale in your front garden, or send mum or dad to work with cakes. To buy: cake ingredients, cases and decorations

CHALLENGE IDEA Showtime

Rally together with a group of friends to put on a show – theatre, dance, music – and sell tickets to parents and friends. To buy: any props, sweets to sell in the interval

CHALLENGE IDEA Jewellery

Make pretty personalised bracelets or necklaces and sell them on for a profit. To buy: beads, and other materials

CHALLENGE IDEA Crazy Cookies

Bake some amazing, colourful cookies and create fun packaging to box them up in. To buy: ingredients, paper bags, arts and crafts materials

CHALLENGE IDEA Movie and Popcorn

Ask your parents to help find a suitable venue, sell tickets to a film night and popcorn packaged in home-made cones. To buy: popcorn, packaging to decorate
